



Venice Water Booster Pump Station

Construction Update September 2024

Work scheduled for September 2024:

Onsite:

- Operations building construction
- Solar field construction
- Above ground pipe assemblies
- Clean fill dirt being delivered to various areas of the project site
- Site grading
- Landscape berm

Offsite installations:

- Install water valve appurtenances on Gene Green and Perimeter Roads
- Install fiber optic appurtenances and pull cable on Perimeter Road

Large equipment and machinery will be within the road right-of-way. Please drive slowly, use caution and watch out for pedestrians and workers. Motorists are to follow posted traffic control signs. This schedule may be subject to change.



The City of Venice currently owns and operates one Reverse Osmosis Water Treatment Plant, which serves approximately 26,000 residents from its location near the Intracoastal Waterway. The City is making improvements to the potable water system by constructing a new Water Booster Pump Station (BPS). The BPS will be located on the northern portion of an approximately 40-acre City-owned parcel at the eastern end of Gene Green Road adjacent to Sarasota County's Dona Bay Surface Water Storage Facility.
