

Work scheduled for March 2026:

The project construction website has reached the end of its useful life and will be permanently retired after March 2026.



The City of Venice currently owns and operates one Reverse Osmosis Water Treatment Plant, which serves approximately 29,000 residents from its location near the Intracoastal Waterway. The City is making improvements to the potable water system by constructing a new Water Booster Pump Station (BPS). The BPS will be located on the northern portion of an approximately 40-acre City-owned parcel at the eastern end of Gene Green Road adjacent to Sarasota County's Dona Bay Surface Water Storage Facility.
